Hello swim schoolers! This November we will be participating in 2 separate promotions for safer swimming (as we are members of both Australian swim school associations). The more messaging around swim safety, the better, which is why we will be running 2 different swim safety weeks in a row! So look out for both campaigns around the centres, and don't be confused when you see two promotions, because they are both trying to achieve the same thing, which is, **to reduce the drowning rate across the nation**. The promotions are:

SwimSAFER Week – Swim Australia – 21st to 27th November 2016.

“No Drown Town” Week – Australian Swim School Association – 28th November to 4th December 2016.

We have also this month launched our **Water Safety Visits** in pre schools and childcare centres, where we educate about water safety through stories, songs and fun!
